This Cookie Policy sets out how and why we use cookies. It also describes the choices available to you regarding our use of cookies. Please read the following carefully to understand our practices. Unless otherwise stated in this policy, by accessing the Good Soil Guide or its applications you are deemed to have accepted the practices described in this policy.

A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers that are stored on your browser. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive (or the hard drive of another relevant device).

The Good Soil Guide uses cookies and similar technologies to authenticate you when you access www.soilguide.co.uk, in order to distinguish you from other members that are accessing the website and its applications, to help us provide you with a good experience when you browse by remembering your user preferences, to help us provide you with more meaningful and relevant platform for information exchange, and to generally improve your experience on the Good Soil Guide.

We also use cookies to collect information about your use of the Site to help improve its performance, in particular which areas you use most often and if you receive any error messages.

Some of the cookies we use are essential for the Good Soil Guide and its applications to operate effectively. If you use your browser settings to block all cookies, including essential cookies, you may not be able to access all or parts of the Good Soil Guide.

Before any non-essential cookies are placed on your device, you will be shown a pop-up message requesting your consent to setting those cookies. By default, most internet browsers accept cookies, but you can choose to enable or disable some or all cookies via the settings on your internet browser. Most internet browsers also enable you to choose whether you wish to disable all cookies or only third-party cookies. For further details, please consult the help menu in your internet browser.

We use the following cookies:

- **Strictly necessary cookies.** These cookies are required to save your session and to carry out other activities that are strictly necessary for the operation of the Good Soil Guide and its applications. They include, by way of general example, cookies that enable you to log into secure areas of the website. These cookies are session cookies, which means they're temporary and will expire when you close your browser.
- **Analytical/performance cookies.** These cookies allow us to recognise and count the number of visitors and to see how visitors move around the Good Soil Guide when they using it. These cookies help us improve the way the website and its applications work, for example, by ensuring that users are finding what they are looking for easily.
- **Functionality cookies.** These cookies are used to recognise you when you return to the Site. They enable us to personalise our content for you, greet you by name and remember your preferences.
- **Targeting cookies.** These cookies record your visit to the Site, the pages you visit, and the links you follow. We use this information to make the platform more relevant to your interests.
- **Social Media cookies.** These cookies work together with social media plug-ins. For example, when we embed photos, video and other content from social media websites, the embedded pages contain cookies from these websites. Similarly, if you choose to share our content on social media, a cookie may be set by the service you have chosen to share content through.

- **Third Party cookies.** We use cookies from our web hosting provider IONOS to collect information about how you navigate through the Good Soil Guide, including information about your computer and your visits to this website such as your IP address, browser type, referral source, length of visit and pages viewed. We use this information to operate and improve the functionality of the Good Soil Guide.

Changes to this cookie policy. We may update this Cookie Policy to reflect changes to our cookie practices. If we make any material changes we will notify you by email, sent to the e-mail address specified in your account, or by means of a notice on the Good Soil Guide front page prior to the change becoming effective. This Cookie Policy and any changes made to it will remain in effect unless and until we inform you otherwise via these means.
